History of the Hinesburg Revolving Loan Fund

The **Hinesburg Revolving Loan Fund** is an offshoot of a loan from the State of Vermont Community Development Program initially made to Vermont Smoke and Cure. This funding allowed Vermont Smoke and Cure to move their business to the Cheese Plant Building which had been extensively damaged by fire. Through this redevelopment activity the Town of Hinesburg was able to support the conversion of the Cheese Plant Building into a multi-use facility that now is home to Vermont Smoke and Cure, Senix Technology, Green Mountain Organic Creamery and Hinesburg Public House.

As this loan is paid back by Vermont Smoke and Cure a portion of the payments are dedicated to creating a fund that can then be re-deployed to support further business development in the town. Thus, the **Hinesburg Revolving Loan Fund** was created.

Its location along the Route 116 corridor provides easy access to Burlington, Williston and Addison County.
